DFM becomes the first Cypriot Ship Management Company to sign up for GSM on their managed fleets.

Dublin, Ireland, 7 November, 2007: Blue Ocean Wireless ("BOW"), an Irish company delivering GSM communication capability for the merchant maritime sector, today announced that, it has been chosen by Dobson Fleet Management ("DFM") to provide GSM coverage for their fleet.

DFM has chosen to evaluate BOW's GSM solution on 5 of their managed container ships. The vessels have a capacity of between 2,100 and 3,500 Twenty-foot Equivalent Units.
